Background: The ordinance approves a grant award between Snohomish County and the Department of Justice (DOJ) under which DOJ will provide the Sheriff's Office with a \$448,000 grant to procure and implement Rapid DNA technology. On December 5, 2024, the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office was awarded a grant from the DOJ for procurement and implementation of Rapid DNA technology. The Sheriff's Office will use this to obtain DNA results within 90 minutes which will aid in criminal investigations and in situations where there may be a natural disaster for identification of individuals.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
