RELATED TO THE 2021 BUDGET; MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FUND 402 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR THE WASTE EXPORT, OPERATIONS, AND ADMINISTRATION PROGRAMS

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental appropriation in the 2021 budget year is necessary in the Solid Waste Management Fund 402, in the amount of \$3,200,000 to provide expenditure authority for higher than anticipated costs associated with higher than anticipated volumes of solid waste.
