## **Consideration**

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 21-424 and Motion 21-425 which would approve and authorize an interlocal agreement between Snohomish County and Snohomish School District for School Resource Officer services at Glacier Peak and Snohomish High Schools.

## Background

The County, through the Sheriff's office, provides contract law enforcement services to agencies throughout Snohomish County, this includes providing School Resource Officers to school districts. The Sheriff's office currently provides School Resources Officers (SRO's) to Everett School District, Sultan School District, Mukilteo School District and Snohomish School District. RCW's 28A.320.124, 28A.320.1242 and 28A.320.125 all provide information related to the nature of the agreements and services performed.

Snohomish School District wishes to renew SRO services at Glacier Peak High School and Snohomish High School.

## **Current Proposal**

## Scope:

- Motion 21-424 approves an agreement to provide SRO services at Glacier Peak High School.
- Motion 21-425 approves an agreement to provide SRO services at Snohomish High School.

Both motions also authorize the executive to execute all related agreements.

Duration: Initial term: upon execution to August 31, 2022. Term may be renewed for up to two (2) additional (1) year terms. Termination is allowed for any reason with thirty (30) days written notice.

Fiscal Implications: \$122,947 per agreement for the initial term (this represents 75% of the total costs given that the deputy is reassigned when school is not in session.)

**2021 Budget:** YES. \$122,947 per agreement for the 2021-2022 school year (total of \$245,894)

**Future Budget Impacts:** \$126,636 per agreement for the 2022-2023 school year (total of \$253,272)

**<u>Handling:</u>** URGENT. (School is in session)

<u>Approved-as-to-form:</u> YES. <u>Risk Management:</u> APPROVE.
