Background

Snohomish County received funds through the CARES Act and appropriated them to Departments and Programs in 2020 and 2021. Funds provided through the CARES Act must be utilized before the end of 2021 on eligible expenses.

When originally appropriated, \$3,031,618.43 in CARES Act funding was allocated to:
