## Consideration

## **Background**

On November 10, 2020, the County Council adopted the 2021 budget via Ordinance 20-075.<sup>1</sup> Superior Court is requesting a budget transfer to balance expenditures in the following programs: Juvenile Court Operations; Superior Court Operations and Superior Court Administration.
