

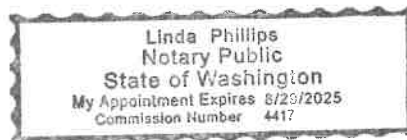

APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF EVERETT

WHEREAS, Snohomish County's main administrative and judicial buildings are located in the Downtown Everett Business Improvement Area, and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County and the City of Everett desire to continue a partnership to increase and maintain the safety, attractiveness, and economic vitality of the Downtown Everett Business Improvement Area, and

WHEREAS, the City of Everett will continue to improve and maintain all public rights-of-way including sidewalks and alleyways located within the downtown area, administer other activities promoting the downtown area, and recognize Snohomish County as financial partner in such activities and promotions; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County and the City of Everett entered into an Interlocal Agreement with an original term beginning on January 1, 2020 and terminating on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to renew the Interlocal Agreement for an additional five (5) years, commencing upon execution and terminating on December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County will pay the City of Everett \$61,936 for the period beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021; and the annual amount paid to the City shall increase by three percent (3%) in each subsequent calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on to consider approving the Interlocal agreement and authorizing the County Executive to sign the Interlocal Agreement on behalf of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

The Snohomish County Council hereby approves and authorizes the Snohomish County Executive, or designee, to sign the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Everett, a copy of which is attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.
