WHEREAS, adequate provisions for the public health, safety and welfare requires the provision of fire and emergency response services; and

WHEREAS, the County Fair Park does not pay property taxes, thus necessitating a services agreement with Snohomish County Regional Fire & Rescue for fire protection services.

WHEREAS, fire protection and emergency response services can be provided in a cost-effective manner by the Snohomish County Regional Fire & Rescue; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Fairgrounds Management, and the Executive recommend approval of an Interlocal Agreement between Snohomish Regional Fire & Rescue and Snohomish County to provide these services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the County Council hereby approves and authorizes the County Executive to execute the an Interlocal Agreement with Snohomish Regional Fire & Rescue in substantially the form as the attached Exhibit A.

At the hearing, the Council may also consider alternatives/ amendments to the proposed ordinance.
