## **Consideration**

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motions 22-241, 22-242, 22-243 and 22-244 which would approve and authorize updates to union agreements, adding Juneteenth as a legal holiday.

## **Background**

SHB 1016<sup>1</sup> was signed by the Washington State Governor on April 20<sup>th</sup>, establishing June 19<sup>th</sup>, recognized as Juneteenth, a state legal holiday.

Ordinance 22-023<sup>2</sup>, scheduled for a public hearing on June 15<sup>th</sup>, amends Snohomish County Code 3A.06 adding Juneteenth as a recognized holiday.

As a result, Human Resources has been working with the collective bargaining units to add Juneteenth to the agreements.
