The County Council makes the following findings of fact: a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$20,789,658.00 is necessary in Human Services Fund 124, for budget year 2022, to provide expenditure authority for rental assistance, utility assistance, administrative expenses, and housing stability services. A grant of \$20,789,658.00 provided to Snohomish County by the Washington State Department of Commerce, will fund these services.
