## **Consideration:**

Authorizing the County Executive to sign the 2022 Collective Bargaining Agreement between Snohomish County and the Public, Professional and Office-Clerical Employees and Drivers Local Union 763 affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters representing Corrections Support.

## Background

This is a three-year agreement with the Public, Professional and Office-Clerical Employees and Drivers Local Union 763 affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters representing Corrections Support, effective January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023. The agreement provides for a Cost of Living adjustment of 1% for 2021, retroactive to April 1, 2021; 3% for 2022 and 2023 adjustments based on 100% of the CPI with a floor of 1.5% and a ceiling on 3.5%. Also included is a lump sum payout in the amount of \$1,000, \$2,000, or \$3,000 to be determined by an employee's top step annual salary. In addition, the agreement includes the addition of Juneteenth (June 19<sup>th</sup>) as a paid legal holiday. The agreement also includes overtime assignment provisions, reincorporates a longevity program and shift premiums of 1% for swing shift and 2% for graveyard shift.

## **Current Proposal**

This motion approves the agreement between Snohomish County and the Union effective January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023, and authorizes the County Executive to sign the agreement.
