Section 1. Adopts ordinance recitals as findings.

Section 2. Finding that the county road right-of-way described in Exhibit A and depicted in Exhibit B is useless for county road purposes and the public will benefit by the vacation.

Section 3. States that the itemized costs and expenses associated with the right-of-way vacation will be absorbed by the County Road Fund.

Section 4. States that the county road right-of-way is vacated upon recording the ordinance with the County Auditor's Office.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may also consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.



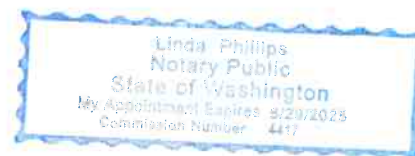
