SOLUTION OVERVIEW

Snohomish County has requested Siemens to assist with additional security to separate the future NSBHO and existing DJJC facility. Project consist of six (6) sally port doors, six (6) cameras, and three (3) exit only doors.

Siemens will utilize all Snohomish County provide spare equipment for this security modification. Re-programming of existing DJJC system to be complete by certified Siemens technician.

SCOPE OF WORK

NSBHO 'Free Egress' Doors (3 total)

- Siemens to decommission all field devices from stairwell doors on 1st and 2nd floors for a total of (3) doors. Included in the decommissioning:
 - capping of the pneumatic assist tubing
 - disabling associated locking hardware
 - o disabling associated intercoms
 - o remove programing from DJJC system
 - *NOTE* All existing devices to be re-installed without security wiring connected, if replacement or plates required, they are to be provided and installed by others.
- Siemens to supply and install (3) panic hardware exit devices. Match existing keyway. Key cores provided by DJJC.

- Siemens to complete security control panel configuration and terminations (electrical room 1-B07 & 2-B07)
 - Programming of DJJC security door control, cams, Intercoms, and Mapping software
 - 10-day system burn-in

 - o Cable and cable installation provided by others (see attached drawing for wire specifics)

Security As-builds:

- Siemens to supply as-build security drawings upon project completion
 - Expand existing Snohomish County security drawing set

Assumptions/Clarifications

- 1. ACAD project drawings: As-builds included in proposal price.
- 2. General Contractor, BnBuilders to supply doors throughout this project. Sally port doors must be fully installed with available low voltage pathway to <u>all</u> security devices. In addition, each door must be furnished with all required security devices (electrified locking hardware, door monitor sensor, pneumatic assist lock, power supply). If devices are not available during installation, Siemens will assist to resolve, and additional cost will apply.
- 3. Cable/Wire, Cable installation, Conduit/fittings and raceways provided by others.
- 4. Pricing includes project management for the duration of the tentative project schedule. Weekly progress meetings are included.
- 5. Siemens to use Snohomish County provided intercoms and cameras. Siemens assumes these devices are full functioning and will satisfy the project requirements. If any re-used material is malfunctioning, Siemens will work with Snohomish County to resolve. Depending on resolution, additional fees may apply.
- 6. Work is assumed to be completed during normal business hours Monday Friday (6am-5pm). Off shift hours will be additional cost.
- 7. Siemens will comply with badging and background check as required by Snohomish County.
- 8. Price based on free access to work areas with the need for special coordination of work.
- 9. Low Voltage electrical permit and schedule inspections with AHJ.
- 10. Prevailing wage project
- 11. Proposal valid for 60 days

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
Exclusions

- 5. Fire Alarm system interface, if required.
- 6. 120VAC by others
- 7. Network connectivity by others
- 8. Performance or Payment bonds.
- 9. Costs associated with schedule acceleration, project meetings, multiple trips onsite due to incompletion of others, or multiple unplanned phases.
- 10. Low Voltage Electrical permit
- 11. Washington State Sales Tax.
