Consideration:

Motion 22-469 would appoint Kimberly Busted to the Snohomish County Planning Commission (Planning Commission).

Background

One of the positions representing District 2 on the Planning Commission is currently vacant. Kimberly Busted has applied to fill the position. Ms. Busted is a licensed engineer with experience preparing land use and construction plans for submittal to a variety of jurisdictions in Washington State. As a District 2 resident with relevant experience, she is well qualified for the county Planning Commission. SCC 2.08.080 provides for nominations of planning commissioners. County Councilmember Megan Dunn is nominating Kimberly Busted to a first full term on the commission.

The Planning Commission has eleven positions, ten of which are currently occupied. Appointment of Kimberly Busted would fill the only current vacancy (although the term of the commissioners representing District 4 is expiring in November 2022 and will be addressed separately).
