Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 22-471 which would approve and authorize the council district allocation for county-related travel.

Background

Snohomish County Code <u>3.36.010</u> provides that the expenses for any business trip outside the State of Washington "by a council member and the council member's designated legislative aide shall not exceed the amount allocated to each councilmember by motion in conjunction with the annual budget for that year".

Current Proposal

Scope: Motion 22-471 allocates \$15,000 as the maximum amount that may be spent on travel per council district. Additionally, the motion indicates that the allocation may also be used for council-district office expenses and that any use of the funds outside of travel will comply with Snohomish County Code departmental budget transfer requirements (SCC 4.26.130).

Duration: Budget Year 2023

Fiscal Implications: \$90,000 (\$15,000 per Council District as well as \$15,000 Non-District expenses)
