**Background:** On June 8, 2022, the Snohomish County Council unanimously approved a motion to integrate the Snohomish Health District and Snohomish County effective January 1, 2023. The ordinance establishes benefits and employment terms for unrepresented Snohomish Health District employees when they become Snohomish County Health Department employees.

# ESTABLISHING INITIAL TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT OF COUNTY EMPLOYEES FORMERLY EMPLOYED BY THE SNOHOMISH HEALTH DISTRICT; AMENDING SCC CHAPTERS 3A.06 AND 3.68

<u>Sections 1, 2 and 3.</u> Defines council adoption, eligible employee, and relation to budget ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> Relating to eligible classified employees' initial rate of pay, anniversary dates, share of cost of medical benefits, and sick and vacation accrual balances.

<u>Section 5.</u> Relating to exempt eligible employees' initial rate of pay, anniversary dates, benefit eligibility, and sick and vacation accrual balances.

<u>Section 6.</u> Amends County Code 3A.06 to include a section relating to benefits for former employees of Snohomish Health District.

<u>Section 7.</u> Referring to SCC 3.6.0101, defines Scope of Charter referring to provisions regarding applicable positions, which include those designated by: elected officials, the county executive and by county executive as confirmed by the council, district court judges, sheriff's office, department heads, defined positions in the superior court, defined positions in the office of hearings administration, the health officer, the law and justice cabinet FTE, deputy prosecuting attorneys as applicable, and professionals within the office of performance auditor, county council and executive office.

Section 8. Amends SCC 3.68.070 referring to leave with pay.

<u>Section 9.</u> Regarding the management exempt compensation plan being expanded to include salary range for the health officer.
