Consideration

The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Ordinances 22-069 and 22-070 which would approve supplemental appropriations in Fund 124 and provide expenditure authority to Human Services.

Background

Snohomish County was awarded additional funds from the Emergency Solutions Grant (US Department of Housing and Urban Development) and the Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance Funds (US Department of the Treasury) in 2022. Both grants were not anticipated when the 2022 budget was developed and additional appropriation authority is needed for the 2022 budget year.
