Consideration:

Approve a one-year time extension to an ILA with French Slough Flood Control District for a Flood Damage Reduction Grant.

Background:

As part of Snohomish County's budget process, the County Council approved the establishment of a Snohomish County Flood Damage Reduction Grant Program, with a total funding amount of \$200,000 in 2021. On May 5, 2021 Council approved Ordinance 21-017 which allocated \$75,450 for French Slough rehabilitation and enhancement of the lower Pilchuck River Levee¹. The initial term of this ILA was from execution through December 31, 2021 and was extended by the Executive as allowed under the agreement until December 31, 2022.
