13	is caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been
14	previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person;
15	
16	WHEREAS, since January 21, 2020, the disease has spread throughout the United States.
17	On January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Health and Human Services secretary Alex
18	Azar declared a public health emergency for COVID-19, beginning January 27, 2020. On
19	February 29, 2020, Washington State Governor Jay Inslee proclaimed a public health emergency
20	for COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, the Snohomish County Health Officer proclaimed a
21	countywide public health emergency for COVID-19. On March 4, 2020, Executive Dave Somers
22	issued a "Local Proclamation of Emergency Snohomish County" for COVID-19 (the
23	"Emergency"). On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared
24	COVID-19 a National Emergency;

26	WHEREAS, on March 22, 2020, the President issued a major disaster declaration, #FEMA-
27	4481-DR-WA COVID-19, under the authority of the Robert T Stafford Disaster Relief and
28	Emergency Assistance Act for the State of Washington;

30	WHEREAS, since March 2020, the County has been responding to the pandemic,
31	including purchasing and distribution of COVID-19 Antigen Test Kits;
