WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Planning Commission is
established and administered pursuant to chapter 2.08 SCC; and
WHEREAS, appointments to fill vacant planning commission
positions are made pursuant to Snohomish County Charter section
2.20 and SCC 2.08.080; and
WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 states that vacancies shall be filled
by the Council with nominees from the County Council and/or
Executive, and
WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080(2) sets out the procedure by which
the County council with hold a public hearing on nominations and

Executive; and WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080(2) sets out the procedure by which the County council will hold a public hearing on nominations and make affirmative findings on the following:

1. Is the nominee a full-time resident of Snohomish County?

2. Is the nominee not a Snohomish County employee except while serving as a temporary appointee?

3. Does the nominee have sufficient time to attend all scheduled commission meetings?

WHEREAS, SCC 2.08.080 also states that it is desirable that the nominee has knowledge of a) land use theories, b) growth management and agricultural preservations studies, c) have a minimum potential for conflict of interest, d) have a demonstrated interest in the welfare of Snohomish County, and e) add balance to county-wide representation on the commission, and WHEREAS, Neil Pederson is a full-time resident of District 4, has applied for the vacancy representing the district, has relevant knowledge, is not a Snohomish County employee, and has indicated the ability and willingness to attend scheduled commission meetings; and

WHEREAS, Neil Pederson has previously served a final number on the Planning Commission, but that term expired in November 2022, and under SCC 2.08.080(5), the current appointment is not consecutive with his prior appointment; and WHEREAS, under Snohomish County Charter section 2.20 and SCC 2.08.080, Councilmember Jared Mead representing District 4 has nominated Neil Pedersen for appointment to the vacant District 4 position for a first full term, to expire four years from the effective date of the position.

has nominated Neil Pedesan to appoint a the design of a position for a first full term, to expire four years from the effective date of this motion; and WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on January 2023, to consider the nomination.

NOW, THEREFORE, ON MOTION, the Shohomish County Council finds that the nominee meets the criteria set out in SCC 2.08.080 and hereby appoints Neil Pedersen to the Shohomish County Planning Commission to serve first full term, which expires on January 2027.
