PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 22-052

AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN ROAD TAX REVENUES FOR PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED IN 2023

WHEREAS, the County Council held a public hearing on November ____, 2022, following public notice as required by law to consider the County's annual budget, including revenue sources for calendar year 2023, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, after hearing and duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, including evidence and testimony presented upon consideration of proposed Ordinance No. 22-051, has determined that an increase in road tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increases resulting from the addition of new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbine facilities, and any increase in the value of state-assessed property under RCW 84.55.010, and from the refund provisions of chapters 84.68 and 84.69 RCW, is necessary in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the County and in its best interests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120, that an increase in property tax revenues for taxes collected in 2023, in addition to the increases resulting from the addition of new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbine facilities, and any increase in the value of state-assessed property under RCW 84.55.010 and from the refund provisions of chapters 84.68 and 84.69 RCW, is hereby authorized in the amount of \$707,984 for the 2023 road levy, which is a percentage increase of one (1) percent from the previous year.

At the hearing, Council may consider alternatives/amendments to the proposed ordinance.

<u>Public Testimony</u>: All interested persons may testify at the time and place indicated above or by remote participation. The chair of the council may choose to limit testimony to three minutes in the interest of accommodating all persons wishing to testify.
