NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on March 1, 2023, the Snohomish County Council approved Ordinance 23-006, which shall be effective March 12, 2023.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-006

APPROVING THE PORT OF EVERETT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CLFR-035a

WHEREAS, Snohomish County has secured Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery (CLFR) grant funds under the federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the Executive Office of Snohomish County created the Office of Recovery & Resilience (ORR) to aid in the distribution of the ARPA funds; and

WHEREAS, both the County and the Port of Everett are public agencies under chapter 39.34 RCW; and; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.01.085 states that economic development programs are a public purpose for counties in Washington state; and

WHEREAS, chapter 53.04 RCW authorizes the Port of Everett to operate rail or motor vehicle transfer and terminal facilities, water transfer and terminal facilities, air transfer and terminal facilities, or any combination of such transfer and terminal facilities, and other commercial transportation, transfer, handling, storage and terminal facilities, and industrial improvements; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the Port of Everett is important to economic development in Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to provide the Port of Everett with \$1,000,000.00 as a subrecipient of federal funds to provide government services in compliance with chapter 53.04 RCW.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The Snohomish County Council approves the Port of Everett Interlocal Agreement (for the period January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2023) in the amount of \$1,000,000 and authorizes the County Executive to sign the Agreement.
