APPROVING AMENDMENT TO WHATCOM COUNTY CONTRACT FOR YOUTH CANNABIS
& COMMERCIAL TOBACCO PREVENTION PROGRAM

Summary: The ordinance authorizes the County Executive, or designee, to execute the amendment to the agreement between Snohomish County and Whatcom County to coordinate implementation of strategies aimed at reducing initiation and use of cannabis and commercial tobacco by youth (ages 12-20) in the North Sound Region. The purpose of this agreement is to support the Snohomish County Health Departments' participation in planning and implementing youth cannabis and commercial tobacco prevention strategies and activities. This amendment extends the duration and other terms of this contract for 6 months and replaces all reference to Snohomish Health District with Snohomish County.

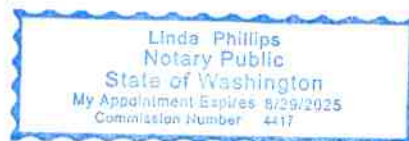
