Consideration:

Approve an agreement with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services for Refugee Health Screening Program.

Background:

The Washington State Department of Social and Health Services has a refugee health screening program where they partner with local health jurisdictions and providers to provide a comprehensive health screening exam to all new refugees within each jurisdiction. The purpose of these exams is to follow up on conditions identified in overseas medical examinations, identify/treat individuals with communicable diseases, and identify conditions that may impact a persons ability to become self-sufficient.¹

The Snohomish Health District has held a contract with the state for Refugee Health Screening in years past, and the proposal before you would continue these services.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Under the contract, the County Health Department will provide refugees resettling within Snohomish County health screenings, interpreter services, coordination with volunteering agencies, follow-ups and referrals as necessary. The County will be responsible for submitting completed refugee screening forms for each refugee to DSHS and a monthly client billing datasheet to DSHS ORIA.

Duration: January 1, 2023 – September 30, 2023

Fiscal Impact: County will receive up to \$257,000.00 for their work under this contract.
