Consideration:

Approve a grant agreement with Latino Educational Training Institute (LETI) to provide advancing health literacy to enhance equitable community responses to Covid-19 grant funding.

Background:

A Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was entered into by the Health District and LETI on November 10, 2021 for the purpose of supporting the advancing health literacy grant. The MOU was effective from September 30, 2021 through June 30, 2023 and provided LETI with \$200,000 for this work.

The District determined that this MOU, along with a few others, should be subrecipient grant agreements and was in the process of changing them prior to the transition of the Health District into the County. While a couple of the replacement agreements were finalized prior to the transition, there were some not finalized including this one.

Current Proposal:

Scope: County will pay LETI up to \$200,000 for work supporting advancing health literacy during the initially established grant period under the MOU (November 2021 - June 2023).

Duration: June 30, 2023

Fiscal Impact: \$200,000
