The Executive's Office requests Council consider approving proposed Motion 23-159 requests a quarterly efficacy report on services provided at county-owned facilities.

Background

On August 17, 2022, the County Council approved Motion 22-330¹ and 22-339² authorizing the execution of two purchase and sale agreements with the intent to purchase two hotels for bridge and permanent supportive housing.

Human Services intends to sub-contract with service providers to provide services to the individuals receiving housing at the county-owned facilities. These services may include, in addition to others, support for transitioning to more permanent housing, substance use treatment, and job-related services.
