## **Consideration:**

The proposed motion would approve and authorize the County Executive to execute a Purchase Agreement and Terms with Quadient, Inc. for new parcel lockers, and associated amendments, under SCC 3.04.140(8).

## **Background:**

Snohomish County Information Technology Department would like to purchase new parcel lockers for the County mail room, to assist with streamlining the County's parcel pick-up system and improve efficiency. The cost savings for purchasing the parcel lockers and associated software and support is approximately 60% less than leasing the lockers for the same time (5 years).

Snohomish County selected Quadient, Inc., through RFP-22-037SB, following established Federal, State and County policies. A Purchase Agreement and Terms between Snohomish County and Quadient Inc. has been negotiated.

## **Current Proposal:**

Scope: The proposed Agreement will allow for the purchase of new parcel lockers and associated software subscriptions and support.

*Duration:* The Agreement is proposed to be effective upon execution and shall terminate five (5) years from contract execution.

Fiscal Implications: The total budget is \$64,197 (this includes an annual 4% increase but does not include applicable sales tax).

**<u>2023 Budget:</u>** This agreement was anticipated in the 2023 budget.

<u>Future Budget Impacts:</u> This agreement will be included in future department budgets.
