Consideration:

Approve two template agreements relating to Naloxone distribution.

Background:

Naloxone is a medicine that reverses the effects of an overdose and can be administered either nasally or through injection.

Prior to the Health Districts integration into the County they held agreements for naloxone distribution to first responders, local jurisdictions, and tribal governments. These agreements both distributed naloxone to the agencies for their use and to leave behind with an individual.

Current Proposal:

These two ordinances would approve two template agreements each, one for local jurisdictions and one for tribal governments, and allow the executive or his designee to enter into individual agreements substantially similar to those attached.

Ordinance 23-047 is the template agreement that would authorize the distribution of naloxone to local jurisdictions and tribal government for their use.

Ordinance 23-048 is the template agreement that would provide local jurisdictions and tribal governments with naloxone to leave behind with individuals they encounter.
