Consideration:

Approve the award of Council Project funds for Second Chance Outreach.

Background:

The Snohomish County Council approved funding for council projects as part of the 2023 adopted budget, further amended by Ordinance 22-001. Second Chance Outreach, founded by Jose Garcia, and Participatory Justice, an organization founded by Kristina Jorgensen have partnered together to engage communities by jails, prisons, and the justice system.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Funds will go to the Participatory Justice – Restorative Justice project. Under the agreement, Second Chance Outreach can be reimbursed for training and stipends of program coordinators, holding classes and related expenses, and indirect costs.

Duration: April 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024

Fiscal Impact: \$100,000
