Consideration:

Approve an increase in FTE within the Health Departments budget by 2.18 FTE.

Background:

The 2023 Budget adopted through Amended Ordinance 22-059 allowed for the addition of 25 FTE countywide throughout the course of the year, subject to Council approval by motion. To date, 8.75 FTE¹ have been approved and 4.18 FTE² are pending consideration/approval.

The 2023 budget for the Health Department included 176.370 FTE. Post integration into the County, the Health Department had 0.82 FTE left for their Public Health Emergency Preparedness Manager and would like to make this a 1.0 FTE, as well as add two addition FTE to support programs and projects authorized in the 2023 budget.

Current Proposal:

Scope: Authorize the increase of FTE within the Health Department by 2.18.

- **Add 0.18 FTE** (this will make an existing FTE a full 1.0 Public Health Emergency Preparedness Manager)
- Add 1.0 FTE Financial Reporting & Audit Supervisor
- Add 1.0 FTE Medical Assistant
