Amendment No. 5 would increase the total not to exceed amount of the contract with AAAE to \$234,950.

<u>Authority Granted:</u> Authorization for the Executive to sign Amendment No. 5.

<u>Background:</u> The Airport wishes to extend an existing contract for training with AAAE by two years. This would include continuation of an annual maintenance and support expense of \$9,100. AAAE provides airport related training to meet Federal Aviation Administration compliance requirements. AAAE also ensures data transmitted to the Transportation Security Administration is secure in accordance with Federal Information Security Management Act and related federal security policies.

The County selected AAAE in 2018 to provide training under RFP 15-18SR and motion 18-144. The original contract amount was \$85,700 and for a duration of two years. The contract provides for extension by a total of ten years in increments of two years each. Some of the prior amendments expanded on the original scope of the training in addition to extending the annual maintenance and support costs. Two of the four previous amendments have included two-year extensions. Two additional two-year extensions would remain possible after Amendment No. 5.
