Accepted packages will create a GRM event and the data will be persisted into a workflow for the County to process. This work is complete.

Description of Change Being Requested (describe here or attach document if needed):

- 1. Create an interface that will allow 3rd party vendors to submit REET Affidavits and accompanying documents and data to Aumentum.
- 2. The interface will allow information to be consumed by a workflow in Aumentum for user processing and subsequently provide completed Affidavit information back to the 3rd parties.
- 3. The interface will generate an event that will start a workflow in Aumentum, routing the data and accompanying documents to the correct queue for processing based on information available in the affidavit.
- 4. It will also handle situations where County personnel reject affidavits with incorrect information in them. These will be returned to the 3rd parties unprocessed for correction and resubmittal.
- 5. The interface will look for duplicate submissions and if the same package is submitted more than once, it will reject the duplicates with a message.
- 6. The interface will also include an endpoint to be used when restamping is required. This can occur when the Auditor finds a problem that requires correction to the Affidavit and the new document simply needs to be stamped again.
- 7. Payment files will be sent by 3rd parties on a daily basis and will be processed using a new batch payment process.

Aumentum Tech Recommended Solution:

- Electronic interface via standard API calls
- Batch Payment Files to be submitted for payment purposes on a daily basis.

Assumptions:

- All Vendors will be able to provide and receive the data packages in a similar format.
- Aumentum will not interface with the Auditor. That interface will be handled by the 3rd Party Vendor.
