RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS;  
REPEALING CHAPTER 7.44 OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY CODE

**Summary:** As part of the creation of a new county health department, the County Council adopted Amended Ordinance 22-062, which repealed multiple chapters of Snohomish County Code (SCC) Title 7, Health and Sanitation. The repealed chapters addressed health and sanitation areas that have long since been administered by the State Board of Health and local health authorities. This proposed ordinance repeals SCC Chapter 7.44, regulating sewer disposals, that was not captured in Amended Ordinance 22-062. Current sewer disposal systems are subject to comprehensive statewide regulations administered by the County Health Department pursuant to RCW and WAC. The County Planning and Development Services Department has also had a nominal role with regulating connections to public sewer and on-site septic systems associated with development activity under the Growth Management Act.

At the Public Hearing, the Council may consider amendments to the proposed ordinance.
