PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The COUNTY, desires to restore the roadway connection of the Index-Galena Road between project design Mileposts 6.088 and 7.032 by constructing a new roadway realigned to the south and east of the original roadway that was damaged during flooding of the North Fork of the Skykomish River in November of 2006. The design phase of the project is nearing completion and there is some additional effort remaining for design services due to an increase in the current scope of work for existing tasks and the addition of new work items for existing tasks not previously scoped. Appeal of the Shoreline Permit has delayed the proposed construction advertisement date.

The CONSULTANT, shall provide the following engineering and services as supplemental to the original and prior supplemental scopes of work. The proposed scope of services is based on discussions with the COUNTY and understanding of additional items of work as described in the following.

SUPPLEMENTAL SERVICES

SCHEDULE AND ASSUMPTIONS

Our understanding is that the current target for advertisement for bidding is now expected in October 2019 to allow construction to begin in early spring of 2020. The project schedule is dependent on completion of the PS&E and environmental permit approvals, and milestones for deliverables of this scope will be developed in consultation with the COUNTY.

This scope of work assumes that the project design to date which is approximately 95 percent complete, will be finalized during this last phase of design services without any major changes to the project design and associated construction documents that would appreciably change the current completion direction and/or schedule.

ESTIMATED LEVEL OF EFFORT

The estimated level of effort to provide these services is shown in Exhibit E-1 and is based upon the scope of work, assumptions, and task descriptions provided following.

Task 25 Project Management

The CONSULTANT will provide additional project administration, management and coordination associated the extended timeframe for completion of the project design and bidding phases. Supplemental project management services for Tasks 25.1 - 25.4 are identified in the associated estimate of effort, Exhibit E-1.

Task 33 PS&E Submittals

The CONSULTANT will provide additional effort for preparation of submittals to complete the project design phase to support changes to the project earthwork and grading following discussions and direction by the COUNTY. The additional effort includes revisions to plans, specifications, and estimates (PS&E) associated with changes to bid items for earthwork and grading, and responses to additional COUNTY comments received.
