Demi has served as a Seattle Suns Board Member and Community Outreach Volunteer (non-profit, youth sports organization), Students of Color Career Conference Volunteer (EVCC Event), and is an ongoing advocate for policies and practices which uphold students' human rights and foster a positive educational environment within her community public schools. Demi has held many volunteer roles in public schools including: Room Parent; Art Docent; Celebration/Festival volunteer; Field Trip Chaperone, Elementary school math helper, Senior Project Interview Prep volunteer; provider of team snacks for sports events.

This nomination has been discussed with Snohomish County Council Representative of District 2, Megan Dunn.

Pursuant to SCC 2.03.030, I hereby urge the Council's confirmation of Demi Chatters to be appointed to the Snohomish County Human Rights Commission to a vacated term ending on June 30, 2022.
