We stand with these tribes, whose ancestors, by signing the Treaty of Point Elliot in Mukilteo in 1855, enabled our county, cities and other communities to exist here. We honor these tribes as they continue to practice their culture and lifeways; including fishing, hunting and gathering and other cultural traditions.

With this tribal land acknowledgement, we open our time together by honoring the ancestors whose feet first knew these lands, and whose paddles still know the waters of what we now call Snohomish County.
