WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, the Washington State
Department of Health confirmed the first reported case of the novel
coronavirus (COVID-19) in the United States in Snohomish
County, Washington COVID-19, a respiratory disease that can
result in serious illness or death, is caused by the SARS-CoV-2
virus, which is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been

COVID-19. On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act
of 2021 was signed into law. The act included emergency rental
assistance.
WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Commerce
has provided such funds to Snohomish County for rental and utility
assistance
