10	WHEREAS, SCC 3.36.035(2) provides that the elected officials designated in
11	SCC 3.36.030 who use their own vehicles for official travel or county purposes may be
12	paid a monthly vehicle allowance at a rate established by ordinance not to exceed 99
13	percent of the average monthly ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance,
14	and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle as determined by the Director
15	of Facilities and Fleet on an annual basis; and
16 17	WHEREAS, the Director of Facilities and Fleet reviewed the average monthly
18	ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance, and fuel expenses of a standard
19	size county pool vehicle pursuant to SCC 3.36.035(2) and determined the cost to be five
20	hundred twenty seven dollars and nineteen cents (\$527.19) for 2022;

22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

24	Section 1. Based upon the Director of Facilities and Fleet's determination that
25	the average monthly ER&R cost of replacement, maintenance, insurance, and fuel
26	expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle is \$527.19 for 2022, the County
27	Council finds that the maximum reimbursement rate authorized by SCC 3.36.035(2) is
28	\$521.92 (99 percent of the average monthly ER&R cost) per month.
29	
30	Section 2. Pursuant to SCC 3.36.035(2), the Council hereby establishes the
31	reimbursement rate for elected officials who use their own vehicle for official travel or
32	county purposes at percent of the average monthly ER&R cost or \$ per
33	month for 2022. In addition to the monthly rate, any elected official designated in SCC
34	3.36.030 may claim reimbursement for mileage traveled by personal vehicle outside
35	Snohomish County for county purposes at the rate authorized by SCC 3.36.020.

Consideration

The proposed ordinance would establish the 2021 monthly vehicle allowance of certain elected officials pursuant to SCC 3.36.035(2)¹.

Background

Snohomish County Code 3.36.035 requires a report of the average monthly ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance, and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle to Council each year. The code allows an elected official using his or her own vehicle for travel for county purposes to be paid a vehicle allowance monthly of not more than 99 percent of the average monthly ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance, and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle as determined by the Director of Facilities Management.

Current Proposal

The Director reviewed the average monthly ER&R cost and has determined that the 2022 rate is broken down as follows:

Average Monthly Vehicle Ownership and	\$436.61
Operating Cost	
AAA Estimated Insurance Cost	\$ 90.58
Total	\$527.19
99% Maximum	\$521.92

The 99 percent maximum payment allowed to an elected official is therefore calculated at \$521.92 per month.

The proposal also allows the Snohomish County Council to adopt the rate calculated by the Director, or Council can set its own rate.

EXECUTIVE RECOMMENDATION:

PURPOSE: To report the 2022 elected official vehicle reimbursement cost to Council

BACKGROUND: Snohomish County Code 3.36.035 requires the Director of the Department of Facilities and Fleet to annually review average monthly ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle and report that average monthly cost to the Council. The Director of Facilities and Fleet has reviewed the average monthly ER&R cost for 2022. The attached memo describes the average monthly ER&R cost. The Council may set the elected official reimbursement for 2022 at not more than 99 percent of the average monthly ER&R cost.

SUBJECT: Elected Officials' Vehicle Reimbursement For 2022

Summary

SCC 3.36.035 allows Council to establish a monthly vehicle reimbursement allowance for elected officials based upon an annual review of ER&R costs by the Director of Facilities.

3.36.035 Payment for elected officials.

(2) In any year for which a monthly vehicle allowance is established by ordinance as provided in this subsection any elected official designated in SCC 3.36.030 using his or her own vehicle for travel for county purposes may be paid a vehicle allowance on a monthly basis of not more than 99 percent of the average monthly ER&R cost for replacement, maintenance, insurance and fuel expenses of a standard size county pool vehicle as determined by the director of facilities management.

Background

Table 1 below shows the background data from which the average monthly ER&R cost was calculated. The miles accumulated on these vehicles are representative of miles traveled by county officials conducting county business. Costs are based on the 2019 and 2020 actual cost of fuel and repair/maintenance, adjusted to 2022 projected costs and using 2019 and 2020 actual usage data for average, and small SUVs owned by the county and selected for similarity in their usage profile.

A small SUV (most typically the Ford Escape) was used due to its commonality as an administrative and/or pool vehicle within the Snohomish County fleet. Sixty-three of

these vehicles are in-use within the fleet, making it the most common, or "standard" pool vehicle.

SCC 3.36.035 requires that the ER&R cost provided by the Director of Facilities for a standard pool vehicle include the cost of insurance. ER&R costs do not include insurance premiums because the County is self-insured, and each department pays a premium to Risk Management that covers County vehicles & equipment operated by employees of the department. In lieu of ER&R costs for insurance, Fleet researched private-party insurance costs and found that according to AAA, the average annual insurance premium for drivers is \$1,087 per year, or \$90.58 per month (https://newsroom.aaa.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/2020-Your-Driving-Costs-Brochure-Interactive-FINAL-12-9-20.pdf).
