ACTION ITEMS

1. Motion 22-393, approving an interlocal agreement between the city <u>2022-0939</u> of Sultan and Snohomish County for disbursement of funds for evacuation trail improvements

Nicole Gorle, Sr. Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report and explained the current proposal to disburse Capital Improvement Funds to the City of Sultan in the amount of \$50,000.00 to install lighting along Evacuation Trail. She said funds were included in the 2022 adopted CIP.

2. Motion 22-404, authorizing an agreement for professional services <u>2022-0976</u> with Bratslavsky Consulting Engineers, Inc. for the Whitehorse Trail Design and Improvements Project

Nicole Gorle, Sr. Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report. She explained this motion would approve an agreement of Subphase 1 of Phase 3 of the project, which would be in effect from execution to March 31, 2023. She also said the consultant would be paid \$202,793.74 and funding was included in the 2022 Budget.

3. Motion 22-405, approving Amendment No. 8 to the Contract for Consultant Services with Bruce Dees and Associates, L.L.C.

Nicole Gorle, Sr. Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report and discussed Amendment No. 8 to the Carousel Ranch Community Park Project. She said a redesign of the project to fit within the existing budget is necessary due to increases in construction costs and that the cost is \$226,809.50.

ACTION: Move to Consent Agenda, General Legislative Session September 28th for consideration.
