Presiding Committee Member Nehring called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. and provided instructions for those wishing to provide public comment for both in-person and remote via Zoom.

ACTION ITEMS

1. Ordinance 23-010, relating to security marshals; amending Section 2.38.050 of Snohomish County Code

Heidi Beazizo, Chief of Staff, provided a staff report. She explained that this ordinance updates language in Snohomish County Code to read "all county courthouse facilities." She explained that this change would allow for Marshal services to be provided at all District Court locations.

2. Ordinance 23-011, approving grant agreement with Darrington
School District to support prevention of and treatment for substance use disorders

Heidi Beazizo, Chief of Staff, provided a staff report. She explained that this agreement would begin at execution and extends through August 31, 2023 and has a total fiscal implication of \$150,000.00.

3. Ordinance 23-013, approving the Interagency Agreement with Department of Ecology for the Pollution Prevention Assistance Program

Heidi Beazizo, Chief of Staff, provided a staff report. She explained that the term of this agreement would extend through June 30, 2023 for a total of \$171,095.63.

Heidi Beazizo, Chief of Staff, provided a staff report. She explained that the FTEs in Fund 130 have an expected end date of 2024 and the FTE in Fund 124 is permanent. She said there is no impact to the General Fund.
