1. Ordinance 23-035, relating to revenue and finance; creating the Public Works Construction Fund and adding a new Chapter 4.130 to Title 4 SCC

Jim Martin, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report on the proposed Code amendments to establish the Public Works Construction Fund to allow flexibility in Roads to budget for construction projects that span over more than one budget cycle.
