1. Motion 22-214, approve and authorize the County Executive to execute the Washington State Department of Commerce System Eviction Rent Assistance Program 2.0 Grant Agreement

Acting Council Chair Mead opened the hearing and the clerk read the motion and ordinance titles into the record.

Heidi Beazizo, Senior Legislative Analyst, provided a staff report explaining the scope of the grant agreement for \$20,789,658 for the period of February 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 to administer the Eviction Rent Assistance Program 2.0. She further explained that the proposed ordinance approves a supplemental appropriation authorizing the expenditure of the grant funds.
