BACKGROUND: Snohomish County is the representative member of the Snohomish County Urban County Consortium (Consortium) for purposes of application, receipt, and administration of federal grant funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG).

The amendment is a substantial amendment to the 2023 Annual Action Plan (2023 AAP) for a Snohomish County CDBG services project.

YWCA of Seattle-King County-Snohomish County - Families in Transition (YWCA-FIT)

Pursuant to Motion No. 23-165, the 2023 Annual Action Plan was approved on May 3, 2023, and included an award of \$139,576 in CDBG funds for the YWCA-FIT project. The project provides home-based case
