PURPOSE: Total recommended ARPA funding available is \$6.5 million in youth programming. This memo is meant to satisfy the ARPA Spending Plan required by the 2023 Adopted Budget Note No. 8.

BACKGROUND: During the Office of Recovery & Resilience’s (ORR) [pandemic recovery engagement](#), supporting youth emerged as an immense need among communities across the county. In response, Executive Somers proposed, and the County Council adopted, a significant allocation focused on youth programming.
