**PURPOSE:** The objective is to complete additional site investigation to address existing data gaps that are critical for completion of a MTCA-compliant Remedial Investigation for the site.

**BACKGROUND:**

- The Airport was approached by the Department of Ecology that funding was available to support continued environmental work at the Former Tect lease area.
- Per Ecology’s request, the Airport completed a Grant Inquiry Form for the site.
- Airport and Ecology have negotiated the terms of the agreement.
- The value of the grant is NTE \$200,000 and work must be performed by June 30, 2023.
