PURPOSE: Approval of the Interlocal Agreement for Overlay Improvements within Alderwood Water &

Wastewater District.

BACKGROUND: The County has been providing Overlay services to various cities and towns for over 25 years. The County currently has Overlay agreements with 18 Cities, Towns and Special Purpose Districts. The County has been providing Overlay services to Alderwood Water & Wastewater District (AWWD) since 2013 and both parties agree that it is mutually beneficial for the County and District to continue working together cooperatively. The County will provide these services to AWWD at its discretion and for the convenience of the County. The County and AWWD have negotiated an ILA for Overlay services through 2035. This agreement is entered into under the regulatory authority of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 39.34.
