PURPOSE: To recommend the appointment of Randy Burge to the Snohomish County Developmental Disabilities Citizen Advisory Board.

BACKGROUND: The Developmental Disabilities Citizen Advisory Board is comprised of citizens who serve in an advisory capacity to the Developmental Disability (DD) staff of the Snohomish County Human Services Department.
