BACKGROUND: In February, the Washington State Supreme Court announced its opinion in <u>State v. Blake</u>, 481 P. 3d 521 (2021) that all previous convictions for simple drug possession were unconstitutional. Any person with a conviction for simple possession has a right to have the unconstitutional conviction vacated from their record. Vacating convictions and resentencing requires substantial and dedicated work by public defenders on behalf of their clients entitled to a legal remedy. In June of 2021, the Washington State Office of Public

Defense notified the Snohomish County it has on cases impacted by State v. Blake. This m	otion is necessary	to ratify the ag	greement with the State Office of
