**PURPOSE:** To recommend the appointment of Charles Adkins to the Snohomish County Children’s Commission.

**BACKGROUND:** The Children’s Commission was created to advise the County on “issues of health, safety and social services for infants, young children and youth in the community.” It is composed of 25 members, including at least two youth commissioners. Three members are appointed from each council district, while the remaining ten at-large appointees may reside anywhere within the county. Commissioners serve four-year terms with the exception of youth commissioners, who serve one-year terms. Commissioners may not serve more than three consecutive terms. The Snohomish County Children’s Commission currently has 8 members and 17 vacancies.

- Mr. Adkins resides in Council District 2 • Mr. Adkins is currently the Children’s Alliance Health Policy Director
- Mr. Adkins is an advocate for children’s healthcare and nutrition
- Mr. Adkins has a BA with an emphasis in Tribal Administration and is an enrolled tribal member • Mr. Adkins is not a member of any other County committee or council
- Mr. Adkins is recommended for an initial four-year term upon appointment
