**PURPOSE:** Approval of the real estate purchase and sale agreement for the purchase of real property identified as APN 28050300202700, located in unincorporated Snohomish County, Washington, for the amount of \$30,000.00, and tenant personal property relocation benefits, and escrow closing costs; and authorize the Property Officer to execute the agreement and all related documents necessary to effectuate the real property transfer.

**BACKGROUND:** Snohomish County owns or has a flood easement on approximately 360 acres of land within an area historically known as Drainage District 6, more recently referred to as the DD6/Chinook Marsh Restoration area ("Restoration Area"), located south of Ebey Slough in unincorporated Snohomish County. The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Surface Water Management Division is the custodial department and manages the Restoration Area all for the purpose of restoration work, providing more open space, and reducing flood risk.
